

Training

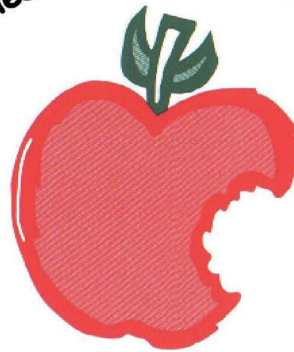
Each agency participating in the CACFP in Kansas must attend a minimum of 6 hours of CACFP approved training each program year. *Around the World with Multi-Cultural Experiences* and *More than a Menu* each provide 2 hours of CACFP training credit.

Other Approved Training Sources

Three (3) of the 6 hours may be obtained from the following agencies: KCGTO, Head Start, KACCRRRA, K-State Research and Extension, Sponsors of Homes, and university or college courses. The class training must focus on food and/or nutrition. Proof of course completion must be submitted to Child Nutrition & Wellness within 30 days after the class.
