<p><b>Decorate</b> with pictures or drawings of sandwich ingredients, the food guide pyramid or different names of sandwiches.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Have students come up with ideas for new sandwiches and crazy names.</li> <li>◆ Play I'm Making a Sandwich (resources).</li> <li>◆ Have students make a collage of foods that would be good to put in a sandwich.
